President's Note:

Highlights discussed during the March Church Council meeting are as follows:

- Preliminary plans for holding a seminar on "Engaging Non-churched People in the Community" are being discussed. This will be open to all members of the congregation. More to come.

- Property is getting bids for janitorial services.
- A motion was approved to renew the Landscaping contract.

- A motion was approved to cover expenses associated with painting the Church Parking Lot Entrance.

- A motion to install raised bed gardens behind the church was approved.

- Outreach is considering a drop box as another way to encourage members to participate in the Each One/Reach One effort.

- Youth Ministry efforts are progressing to reach out to past confirmands and their parents to get input on what we can offer to keep our youth engaged beyond Confirmation.

- The last day of Sunday School will be May 21. A suggestion to have a church picnic on that day is being considered.

- Social Ministry is looking at providing pastries for the Easter Breakfast, plus potentially sponsoring a garage/rummage sale in the future.

- The next Church Council meeting is scheduled for Sunday, April 16, 2023, at 7PM.


