We feel as if we are stuck with these anomalies and therefore must compensate for them. This seems to manifest as anger, spite, people pleasing, and a host of other maladies.

There is, however, no shame in being in Christ. Jesus was heaped with scorn and shame and endured being crucified. He is resurrected from the dead and now has the place of highest honor and the name that is above all names. His Father, and ours, placed him there.

In Christ, God has transferred us from those places of shame into his place of honor, a product of our baptismal heritage into Christ, for:

he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.-- Titus 3:5-7


