#### **FEBUARY 2019 NEWSLETTER**

We had a good turnout on the 27th for our annual congregational meeting. This capped off a 20-year run by Janice Prospero as our Financial Secretary. Those in attendance got to hear Janice give her final report as our Financial Secretary. Janice hands the reigns officially off to Tamara Doerrer, whose experience as an Accountant will surely be useful to her in her capacity as our Financial Secretary. We look forward to working with Tammy on council and despite the tremendous efforts Janice put in over the years, we are confident that Tammy will serve the congregation well in this role.

Attendees at this year's annual meeting also got to hear about several other things, a few notables being:

- the many capital improvement projects that were completed in 2018
- our final report on giving in 2018 (about \$3,000 more than 2017 thank you to ALL for your generous giving!)
- our budget for 2019 (up about 2% due principally to higher benefit costs and a 2% pay raise for our employees)
- plans for a Trinity Tailgate in June that will be open to all members (co-sponsored by outreach and Social Ministry)
- an upcoming benefit concert at Trinity on Saturday, February 16th from 7-9 p.m. (free entry and a free-will offering will go to our Youth, six of whom are planning to attend the National Youth Gathering in Minneapolis in July)
- Explore God Chicago an outreach program aimed at answering some questions many people have about God. This will be the subject of Pastor Hoag's sermons during Lent this year.
- plans for our kitchen remodel (much of this remains tentative at this time, but we hope to have plans available in time that you can see at Trinity so you know what we're hoping to accomplish with this project)

These are some highlights that come to mind. We had a good Q&A session at the end of the meeting where some great questions gave rise, leading to some productive conversations. We remain in a good place as a congregation, and we have reason to be optimistic about our future at Trinity Lutheran Church.

This is a recurrent theme but give some thought in 2019 to inviting a friend or two to join us for services. While our total membership is up in 2018, our attendance is modestly

down (our average per service declined from 56 to 55 this year, but we had 50 fewer attendees in 2018 on two fewer services). We know from research that one of the main reasons people decide to start regularly attending a church is because a member of that church asked them to join them. Maybe this process takes a few tries but make a point of asking a friend to join you at Trinity this year.

Here's to a great 2019! Thank you all for your membership.
