President's Notes:

December was a busy month for us at Trinity with many church activities and events leading up to our special Christmas services celebrating the Birth of Christ. We started the month with a successful Cookie Walk and ended with a fun Christmas VBS Night with the Sunday School. The Church Council would like to thank **all of you** who helped make these events and the ones in between possible.

For those of you who happen to watch *ABC Nightly News* with David Muir, you may have noticed he always ends his broadcast with a positive message. I think our year, 2023, has ended on a positive note. We are seeing new faces in the congregation and our members are pulling together to make our congregation stronger. I'm looking forward to 2024 and all that is possible in our congregation.

Highlights discussed during the December Church Council meeting are as follows:

- General Fund Donations year to date through November are \$16,300 less than the same period in 2022.
- Tim King presented a proposal from B.T.S. to replace telephone and internet service with VOIP providing a savings of over \$200.00/month and new phone equipment. The council approved a motion to switch to the new provider. Nice job Tim!
- Property reported meeting with our janitorial service to review cleaning issues. Property directors performed a walk around inspection during a rain to look for any leaks. Plans for upgrading exterior lighting are still under consideration.
- Youth and Parish Education are planning the Sunday School Christmas Program on Sunday December 17th. Sunday School has added 13 new students since September! A one day VBS during Christmas is scheduled for the evening of December 27th.
- Parish Education is inviting members to participate in "The Bible Recap" initiative.
- Council elections results were discussed. Gary Purnell has volunteered to remain as President for 1 more year. The Director of Outreach position is still open.
- The Annual meeting is scheduled for February 4th. Social Ministry will coordinate the Potluck luncheon.
- Over \$1,900 was raised from the Cookie Walk. Use of the funds has yet to be determined.
- The next Church Council meeting is scheduled for Sunday, January 14, 2023, at 7PM.


