
Dear Friends,

Highlights discussed during the February Church Council meeting were as follows:

- As a step in our Re:Vitality effort, Pastor led a discussion on engaging nonchurched people in our community. More to come.

- Property reported the preschool and bathroom lights have been updated to LED. Repairs are being made to improve the security of the basement doors. Repairs and painting of the white boards behind the banners on the sides of the Church Sanctuary are complete. A proposal to install raised bed gardens behind the church will be reviewed at next months meeting.

- Outreach continues to encourage members to participate in the Each One/Reach One effort. Spiritual fitness and well-being of members is a topic under consideration.

- Youth Ministry efforts are progressing to reach out to past confirmands and their parents to get input on what we can offer to keep them engaged beyond Confirmation.

- Parish Education reported the Love Smiles event and Valentines Day party were well attended. Activities were focused on the Power of Prayer.

- Wednesday Lenten dinners are scheduled at 5:30. A potential volunteer for the Easter Breakfast committee chairperson has been identified. We are seeking more volunteers to assist.

- Sharing of the Peace during services has been temporarily suspended due to the recent Covid outbreak among our members.

- The next Church Council meeting is scheduled for Sunday, March 12, 2023, at 7PM.
