Dear Friends,

I would like to take this opportunity to calm some fears about what is going on right now in the Middle East. There's a lot of speculation about the end of the world. References are being made to the prophets, namely, Ezekiel and Daniel, and Revelation. The gist of what's being said is that we are seeing the last days of planet Earth being played out on the global stage and that it was predicted by the Bible.

All of it exhibits a very poor understanding of the Bible. Ezekiel and Daniel are explicitly about the *coming of the Messiah*, what he will accomplish and under what conditions he will come. Their fulfillment came in the person of Jesus Christ and not in current geopolitical realities.

The Bible interprets itself very well and has Jesus Christ alone as its focus and center. Do not deviate from Jesus, in whom we have assurance that the forces of the demonic realm have been conquered and will meet their final doom when Jesus reappears once and for all. Know that you are forgiven of all sin and are kept from all evil through the cross and resurrection of Jesus. You are his forever!

# An update from Church Council President, Gary Purnell:

President's Note:

A big thank you to Outreach, Social Ministry, Parish Education, Church Council, specifically Mike Gardner, and all else involved for all the heart and energy put into our "Back Home with Jesus" Sunday. Thank you to Pastor as well for his very informative and welcoming service. I know a lot of work went into the morning to make it special from preparing the food to welcoming the congregation to entertaining our Sunday School children, etc. Your efforts did not go unnoticed. I saw a lot of fellowship and smiles happening. Let's keep those welcoming smiles going. Please when you notice a new guest or even a member who does not seem to have anyone to visit with, offer your friendship. A little kindness goes a long way.

Highlights discussed during the September Church Council meeting are as follows:

- General Fund Donations year to date through September are \$13,200 less than the same period in 2022.
- Expenses for September were generally in line with the same period last year except for the parking lot project.
- Property, Liability, and Workers Comp Insurance for 2024 should go out for bid.
- Property reported repairs to plumbing, gutters, siding and trim. Gables and windows need to be scraped and painted and should be budgeted for 2024. Plans for upgrading exterior lighting are in process.
- Outreach, Social Ministry, and Parish Education discussed plans for "Back Home with Jesus" Sunday.
- Youth and Parish Education are planning a bonfire on October 21 and a game night on November 10.
- Council elections are scheduled for October 22. Three openings still exist. A discussion of potential candidates was held. Pastor will follow up.
- The next Church Council meeting is scheduled for Sunday, November 12, 2023, at 7PM.


