OCTOBER 2023 NEWSLETTER

An update from Church Council President, Gary Purnell:

President's Note:

The congregation will be electing Council Members on the 22nd of October. Of the 12 positions on the Council, four of them are up for election. The following is a list of the positions that will need to be filled including a brief description:

- Church President Presides over the Council meetings, Communicates with the Pastor and the Congregation
- Treasurer Manages the Church's finances, Pays bills and salaries, Administers payment of FICA, budgeting, etc.
- Director of Outreach Reaches out to members and nonmembers in an effort to provide support and encouragement and to maintain/increase membership
- Director of Worship and Spiritual Life Assists the Pastor in matters pertaining to the spiritual welfare of the congregation, assists in planning and carrying out the worship services of the congregation and encourages members to faithful attendance **Diane Sewing has expressed willingness to run again for Director of Worship and Spiritual Life.

You may contact myself or those presently serving for more detailed information. To be eligible, members of the Council must be a communicant member of the church in good standing, be over 21 years of age, and comply with the Constitution of this Congregation.

The church needs the support of the Church Council to run smoothly. If you think you might be a good fit for any of the above positions or if you know of someone who might be a good fit, please let Pastor or myself know. The Council meets as a collective group once a month to discuss progress, issues, and vote on matters at hand. Presently, we have a great group of volunteers who are working very hard behind the scenes to keep our church functioning. We hope you will consider joining this dedicated group.

Highlights discussed during the September Church Council meeting are as follows:

- General Fund Donations year to date through August are \$12,600 less than the same period in 2022.
- Expenses are generally in line with the same period last year except for lift repairs, the masonry project (tuck pointing), and utilities.
- Property reported an extensive list of maintenance items completed over the summer months. Plans for upgrading exterior lighting are in process.
- Outreach has sent care packages to our college students and has scheduled October 15 as "Back Home With Jesus Sunday."
- Parish Education's theme this year is "Be the Light!"
- Social Ministry sent out 20 backpacks with school supplies.
- The next Church Council meeting is scheduled for Sunday, October 8, 2023, at 7PM.


